

TOWN OF SEXSMITH

BYLAW NO. 857

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SEXSMITH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO RESCIND BYLAW NO. 794, THE TOWN OF SESMITH OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE BYLAW IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF HE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, REVISED STATUES OF ALBERTA 2000, CHAPTER M-36

WHEREAS, Section 18 (2) (b) of the Off-Highway Vehicle Act, being Chapter 0-4, Statutes of Alberta, 1980 provides that the Council of a municipality may by order, authorise and restrict the operation of off highway vehicles on highways under its direction, control and management.

AND WHEREAS, the Off-Highway Vehicle Act, Chapter 0 – 4, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980, has been repealed and replaced with the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-6, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Sexsmith has deemed that Bylaw 794 is no longer required and is requesting to have the Bylaw rescinded;

AND WHEREAS, Council has received and read letters of concern regarding the abuse of the provisions of Bylaw 794 and deem that it is in the best interests for the safety of the residents of Sexsmith to rescind Bylaw 794;

AND WHEREAS, the Notice of Intention to rescind Bylaw 794 has been duly circulated by publication in the May 2007 edition of the *Sexsmith Sentinel*;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that Bylaws 794 and 725 are hereby rescinded as the use of off-highway vehicles is no longer acceptable within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Sexsmith, and further that this Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on November 1, 2007

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 23rd DAY OF JULY, 2007.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 21st DAY OF OCTOBER, 2008.

READ A THIRD AND FINAL TIME THIS 7th DAY OF APRIL, 2008.
