

**TOWN OF SEXSMITH**

**BYLAW NO. 885**

**BEING A BYLAW IN THE TOWN OF SEXSMITH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 755, THE TOWN OF SEXSMITH LAND USE BYLAW**

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Sexsmith has adopted a Land Use Bylaw; and

**WHEREAS** the Council has the authority under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26.1 with amendments, to Amend the Land Use Bylaw; and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Sexsmith deems it desirable to amend the Land Use Bylaw

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town duly assembled, hereby enacts the following:

- 1) The removal of the requirement in CL (Commercial Light) and C2 (Highway Commercial) Districts to construct using the 1920's – 30's historical façade. However, historical design is recommended.

**READ A SECOND TIME THIS 3<sup>RD</sup> DAY OF MAY, 2010.**

**READ A THIRD AND FINAL TIME THIS 3<sup>RD</sup> DAY OF MAY, 2010.**
